## Feeding Directions

Feed up to 0.5 pound to 0.75 pounds per 100 pounds of the horse's body weight daily, with liberal amounts of quality forage. Most pleasure horses will stay in top condition on three to six pounds per day. Depending on size and weight, increase by one to five pounds per when horse's activity level increases.

This fed is formulated for the backyard pleasure horse, the saddle bred, the parade horse and horses not currently in the moderate work, breeding or performance situations.
