Ingredients

Beet molasses, soybean meal, processed grain by-products, hydrolyzed vegetable fat, monocalcium phosphate, dicalcium phosphate, limestone, zinc sulfate, manganese sulfate, copper chloride, ethylenediamine dihydriodide, cobalt carbonate, sodium selenite, vitamin A acetate, vitamin D₃ supplement, vitamin E supplement.

Feeding Directions

Provide free-choice as a supplement to all classes of goats. Feed at the rate of one block for each 15 to 30 head. Place blocks in each pasture or paddock near areas frequented by goats, such as watering locations, shade or loafing areas. Goats normally consume between 2 and 4 ounces per head daily. Consumption may vary depending on climate, browsing/grazing conditions, and availability of other feeds. In situations where consumption is less than 2 ounces per head daily, intake can be increased by providing additional blocks in each pasture.

Provide access to fresh water and free-choice salt at all times.
