### Ingredients

Cane molasses, processed grain by-product, dicalcium phosphate, monocalcium phosphate, cottonseed meal, hydrolyzed vegetable oil, manganese sulfate, zinc sulfate, ethylenediamine dihydriodide, cobalt carbonate, ground limestone, vitamin A supplement, vitamin D<sub>3</sub> supplement, sodium selenite, and vitamin E supplement.

### Feeding Directions

Provide free-choice as a supplement to sheep at a rate of one block for each 25 to 35 head. Place blocks in each pasture near areas frequented by livestock, such as watering locations, shade or loafing areas. Sheep will typically consume 3 to 4 ounces per head per day. Consumption may vary depending on climate, grazing conditions, condition of livestock and/or availability of other feeds. In situations where climate and/or other factors result in less than the daily expected consumption, intake of supplement can be increased by increasing the number of blocks per pasture.

**Sheep 16% should be used as the sole source of supplemental trace minerals.**

**Provide access to fresh water and free-choice salt at all times.**
